

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) publishes the “gold standard” for comparative risk-adjusted data on patient outcomes across hospitals in the U.S.

According to their data:

- **2021 was the fourth consecutive year in which Maimonides’ overall performance across the clinical conditions for which survival rates were measured places it among the *top ten in the country*.**
- **On the CMS measure for heart attack survival, Maimonides is *#1 in New York for the 4<sup>th</sup> straight year* and *#2 in the nation***
- **On the CMS measure for stroke survival, Maimonides is among the *Top 1% in the nation for the 4th year in a row***
